



Stone is the purest and most natural building material of all. Each piece is unique and can never be replicated.

A tile or paver made from stone has been quarried, sawn to the right size and then machined to make the thickness uniform – this simple process is all that is required to create an extraordinarily beautiful natural product. Sometimes special surface treatments such as tumbling, honing, brushing or flaming are applied. These simple physical processes require no artificial additives or chemicals.

Stone is a natural choice for passive heating and cooling. In winter stone is slow to heat but retains its heat for a long time. In summer, stone will stay cool for longer, especially indoors.

Test results for flexural strength, density, porosity, water absorption, slip resistance and resistance to salt attack assist design professionals in determining commercial suitability.

Bellstone's 5-star quality rating system

To help you interpret the test data about stone quality we have devised a simple rating system. Test results have been converted to star ratings, based on a linear scale for each parameter. This helps you make an informed choice before buying or specifying the right stone for your interior – matching fitness for purpose is a high priority for us.

Does stone need any special maintenance?

The best quality stone can provide the toughest, most resilient indoor and outdoor floor surfaces known to humankind.

If a new stone surface is cleaned regularly it will retain its character and vitality for many generations. Old stone floors can be brought to life quickly and inexpensively with modern cleaning agents specifically designed for stone.

Does stone need sealing?

Much of the stone we supply does not require sealing. However, the majority of our customers prefer to seal – it's a kind of insurance for them. It takes only minutes to seal a floor. The best sealants can last for up to 15 years and they can make cleaning easier, so we understand why this is a popular choice.
